Welcome to the **Foreign Language Resource Center (FLRC)** at NSU. We are located on the third floor of Kyser Hall, room 335. Our multiuse facility provides faculty and students with multi-media tools to enhance their language learning and language teaching experience. We welcome all students to take advantage of our facility, which is comprised of 8 computers, a break area, a tutoring area, and a conference table for group projects.

Our computers are equipped with headsets for listening, microphones for speaking, and webcams for video chatting. Each computer has Microsoft Office installed for writing papers or creating a visual presentation. Foreign Language students, French and Spanish minors can also use our printer for their projects.

Our film collections boast over 400 movies in French and Spanish which can be viewed in the lab. The FLRC also offers a growing collection of dictionaries, workbooks, textbooks, and professional tools (Spanish for nursing, Spanish for Law enforcement, French for Business etc.) to help our students go beyond the classroom.
