I. COLLEGE OF NURSING

- A. Add the following new courses for undergraduate credit:
- NURA 1080 – Paramedic/Medic Nursing Transition (3-3-0).
  - NURA 1081 – Introduction to Nursing Skills (2-1-1).
- B. Make the following course changes:
- NURA 1160 – change corequisite.
  - NURA 1550 – change hour values to (2-2-0) and change prerequisite.
  - NURB 2170 – change hour values to (1-1-0).
  - NURB 3060 – change hour values to (3-3-0).
  - NURB 3061 – change hour values to (3-1-6).
  - NURB 3130 – change hour values to (4-4-0).
  - NURB 3160 – change hours values to (3-3-0).
  - NURB 4120 – change hour values to (4-4-0).
  - NURB 4130 – change hour values to (3-3-0).
  - NURB 4220 – change hour values to (3-3-0).
- C. Make the following changes to the Associate of Science in Nursing (400) program:
- Add new concentration – Medic/Paramedic to ASN.
  - Curriculum:
    - 1<sup>st</sup> year – Add: NURA 1160 (1 hour)
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> year – Add: NURA 1550 (2 hours); Delete: Social Science<sup>4</sup> (3 hours)
    - Revise footnotes to read:
      - Selected from Mathematics 1020-1060, 1020-1090, 1020-2010, 2100-2110.
      - Before entering nursing courses, student must meet all criteria listed in the special admissions policies listed in the University Catalog.
      - Nursing 1060 is required for LPN to ASN student in place of Nursing 1050.

- Nursing 1080-1081 is required for the Medic/Paramedic to ASN student in place of Nursing 1050.
- LPN to ASN and Medic/Paramedic to ASN students will receive credit for course, if requirements are met per APDG policy.

D. Make the following changes to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (410) program:

- Add new concentration – BS to BSN.
- Major Requirements: Delete: NURB 2160, 3240, 3260; Add: NURB 4950.
- Curriculum:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> year: Delete: Behavioral Science<sup>1</sup> (3 hours), COMM 1010, NURB 2160; Add: Social Science<sup>2</sup> (3 hours).
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> year: Delete: Social Science<sup>1</sup> (3 hours), ALHE 1020; Add: COMM 1010
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> year: Delete: NURB 3260, NURB 3240; Add: Fine Arts 1040, History<sup>2</sup> (3 hours).
  - 4<sup>th</sup> year: Delete: Fine Arts 1040, History<sup>1</sup> (3 hours); Add: Behavioral Science<sup>2</sup> (3 hours), NURB 4950.
  - Revise footnotes to read:
    - <sup>1</sup> Selected from mathematics 1020-1060, 1020-2010, 2100-2110.
    - <sup>2</sup> See University core.
    - <sup>3</sup> Before entering nursing courses, student must meet all criteria listed in the special admission policies listed in the University Catalog.
    - <sup>4</sup> LPN to BSN students will receive credit for classes, if requirements are met per LPN to BSN APDG.
