

For each semester hour of credit, a traditional lecture or laboratory course shall strive to meet a minimum of 750 minutes. Final exam periods may be counted as class time when computing required minutes. The minimum length requirements for academic courses are listed below:

A. Minimum requirements for meeting time for classes:

1. 1 hour classes must meet 750 minutes.
 - a. 50-minutes classes must meet 15 times, or 14 times plus final examination.
2. 2 hour classes must meet 1500 minutes.
 - a. 50-minute classes must meet 30 times, or 28 times plus final examination.
 - b. 100-minute classes must meet 15 times, or 14 times plus final examination.
3. 3 hour classes must meet 2250 minutes.
 - a. 50-minutes MWF classes must meet 45 times, or 42 times plus final examination.
 - b. 75-minutes TuTh classes must meet 30 times, or 28 times plus final examination.
 - c. 150-minutes weekly classes must meet 15 times, or 14 times plus final examination.

B. Final Examination time requirements:

1. Scheduled time minimum requirements
 - a. 1 hour courses -- 50 minutes
 - b. 2 hour courses -- 100 minutes
 - c. 3 hour courses -- 150 minutes
