

DSST

(DANTES Subject Standardized Test)

Any prospective or enrolled student who attains satisfactory scores on Northwestern State University approved subject examinations of the Dantes Subject Standardized Test (DSST) administered by or under the auspices of the Prometric Testing Service is eligible to receive credit on the basis of such tests. DSST testing is provided by the NSU Testing Center. Examinations are given by appointment excluding December and March, at Northwestern. Students may also arrange to take DSST tests at other centers and use recipient code 8671 to have their scores reported to Northwestern. Students applying for credit for NSU-approved DSST Examinations must have scores sent directly to Northwestern State University from Prometric. A DSST Examination should be taken well in advance of the semester during which the student would normally register for the course involved.
