I. College of Arts & Sciences

A. Make the following changes to the Liberal Arts (220) degree program:

• Revise Major Requirements to read:

- Students seeking a degree in Liberal Arts, outside the Louisiana Scholars' College, must complete 68 hours within the 120 semester hour Liberal Arts curriculum, which include: 15 hours of courses at the 1000 and 2000 level, 27 hours of courses at the 3000 and 4000 level or from a concentration area, and 26 hours selected from a concentration area or from courses within the humanities and the social/behavioral sciences. These courses can include any of the following: Art; Dance; Fine Arts; Music; Theatre; Anthropology; Criminal Justice; Economics; Geography; History; Philosophy; Political Science; Pre-law and Paralegal Studies; Sociology; Unified Public Safety Administration; Communication; English; any foreign language; Addiction Studies; Psychology; Social Work.

- Revise curriculum footnotes 4, 5, and 6 to include the following list of courses to satisfy elective hours:
 - Art; Dance; Fine Arts; Music; Theatre; Anthropology; Criminal Justice; Economics; Geography; History; Philosophy; Political Science; Pre-law and Paralegal Studies; Sociology; Unified Public Safety Administration; Communication; English; any foreign language; Addiction Studies; Psychology; Social Work.
- Delete the Social Issues (220I) concentration.

ACTION: All items approved without opposition.

II. Department of English, Foreign Languages, and Cultural Studies

- A. Delete the follow course:
 - ENGL 4050 – Senior Seminar (3-3-0).
- B. Make the following course change:
 - ENGL 4800 – change course title and description.
- C. Add the following new courses for undergraduate credit:
 - ENGL 3930 – Black British Writers (3-3-0).
 - ENGL 4700 – Literature and Culture (3-3-0).
 - ENGL 4810 – Senior Seminar (3-3-0).
- D. Make the following changes to the English (221) curriculum and the LSC joint major program (822) (where applicable):
 - Revise major requirements to:
 - (60 semester hours) A student majoring in English will successfully complete 60 semester hours, within the 120 semester hour English curriculum, which includes a 9 semester hour English core, 12 semester hours of foreign language coursework, and a 39 semester hour concentration.

Core: (9 semester hours) English 2070, 4800, 4810.

Foreign Language: (12 semester hours) All twelve semester hours must be in the same foreign language – either French or Spanish 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020.

Concentration: (39 semester hours as defined below).

- Revise concentration requirements to:
 - **Literature (221A):** English 3100, 3150, 3160, and 3170; English 4420; three hours from English 3800, 3910, 3920, 4230, 4873, or 4970; six hours from English 3400, 4130, 4140, 4170, 4190, 4200, 4210, 4250, 4260, 4350, 4430, or 4570 six hours from English 3800, 4240, 4310, 4330, 4360, 4400, 4450, 4490, 4590, 4650, 4690, 4750; and nine semester hours of advanced English courses.
 - **Professional Writing (221B):** 6 hours chosen from English 2090, 2100, 2510, or 2610; English 3190; English 3230; 3 hours chosen from English 3210, 3300, or 3610; English 3200 or 4110; English 4040 or 4790; eighteen hours of advanced English courses (courses numbered 3000 or 4000).
 - **Folklife-Southern Culture (221C):** English 4670, 4650; eighteen hours in literature of the American South and Folklore from English 4240, 4320, 4340, 4690, 4750-01, 4750-02, 4770, 4790, 4870, 4873, or 4880; and fifteen hours of advanced English courses.
 - **Film Studies (221D):** English 3500, 3510, 3520, 3610, and 4340; fifteen hours in film and film studies from English 3530, 3540, 3620, 4710, 4750-03, 4870, 4970, or 4980; and nine hours of advanced English courses.
- Make the following changes to the curriculum:
 - 1st year –
 - Delete: Social/behavioral science¹ (3 hours); Electives² (2 hours).
 - Add: Foreign Language² (6 hours).
 - Increase year total from 30 to 31 semester hours.
 - 2nd year –
 - Delete: ENGL 2110 (3 hours); Electives² (9 hours); Social/behavioral sciences¹ (3 hours).
 - Add: Social/behavioral sciences¹ (6 hours); English concentration (6 hours); Electives³ (3 hours).

- 3rd year –
 - Delete: English concentration (15 hours); Foreign language (6 hours).
 - Add: English concentration (21 hours).
- 4th year –
 - Delete: Electives² (15 hours); English concentration (15 hours).
 - Add: English 4800 (3 hours); English 4810 (3 hours); English concentration (12 hours); Electives³ (11 hours).
 - Decrease year total from 30 to 29 semester hours.
- Revise and renumber footnotes as follows and apply renumbering to curriculum where needed:
 - ¹Refer to University core requirements.
 - ² All twelve semester hours (1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020) must be in the same foreign language.
 - ³ Electives may be chosen so as to complete a minor as defined by the department concerned.

ACTION: All items approved without opposition.

III. Department of Criminal Justice, History and Social Sciences

- A. Make the following changes to the University Core:
 - Add Criminal Justice 1100 as an option to satisfy the social science component for baccalaureate and associate degrees.
 - Remove Philosophy 1010 as a course to satisfy the social science component for baccalaureate and associate degrees and add it as an option under the humanities component.
- B. Add the following statement to the UPSA Law Enforcement Administration concentration (256A):
 - Students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science degree in Unified Public Safety Administration, Law Enforcement Administration concentration (256A) and have successfully completed the requirements set by the Louisiana Police Officer Standards and

Training (P.O.S.T.)* Council for the police academy will be given credit for the following courses once they present their credentials to the University: CJ 1100, 2300, and nine hours of electives.

*Other states equivalency certificates will be accepted in lieu of the Louisiana P.O.S.T. certificate.

- C. Revise requirements for the Public Facilities Management (256D) concentration to read:
 - (24 semester hours) MKTG 3230; MGT 3220; UPSA 2550, 3000, 3600, 4100, 4400, and 4700.
- D. Add UPSA 3000 and UPSA 3600 as approved electives for concentrations 256A, 256B, and 256C.
- E. Make the following changes to the Resource Management (258) degree program:
 - Add the following new concentration:
 - Health Science Administration (258F): (40 semester hours) Allied Health 2020, 2200, 2400, 3000, 3900, 4230, 4430, 4520, 4600, 4630, and 4900; UPSA 2250 and 4350.
 - 4th year – change concentration area courses to variable 18-19 hours.

ACTION: All items approved without opposition.

IV. Department of Music

- A. Add the following new course for undergraduate credit:
 - MUS 4270 – Vocal Pedagogy II (3-3-0).

V. School of Allied Health

- A. Make the following course changes:
 - ALHE 4900 – change hour values from (5-5-0) to (6-6-0).

 - RADS 5510 – change course title, course description, and course syllabus.
 - RADS 5530 – change course title, course description, hour values, and course syllabus.
- B. Delete the following courses:

 - RADS 5410 – Special Topics in Radiologic Science Education
 - RADS 5520 – Clinical Radiologic Sciences Practicum
 - RADS 5420 – Special Topics in Radiologic Science Administration
- C. Make the following changes to the RT to BSRs (615A) concentration:
- 4th year – Delete: Electives (2 hours); ALHE 4900 (5 hours)
Add: Electives (1 hour); ALHE 4900 (6 hours)
 - Increase total semester hours required for the major from 73 to 74 based on credit hour value change for ALHE 4900.
- D. Make the following changes to the Allied Health (620) degree program:
- Add ALHE 2020 and ALHE 2400 as options to satisfy Health Science and Technology (620A) concentration requirements.
 - 3rd year – Add: ALHE 3000 as an option to ALHE 3840 and COMM 2500 as an option to COMM 1010.
 - 4th year – Delete ALHE 4900 (5 hours); Electives (3 hours)
Add: ALHE 4900 (6 hours); Electives (2 hours)
- E. Make the following changes to the Radiologic Sciences (549) degree program:
- Delete: RADS 5520; Electives (0-3 hours): RADS 5080, RADS 5410, and RADS 5420.
 - Reduce total degree hours from 39 to 33.

- I. Make the following change to the Pre-Pharmacy (618I) pre-professional program:
- 1st year – Delete: HED 1010; Add: UNIV 1000.
 - 2nd year – Add: BIOL 2020-2021; ENGL 3110.

- 3rd year –Delete: ECON 2000 or 2010, PHYS 2030-2031; Add: BIOL 3060, 4190-4191, 4280 and 3 hour Social Science elective.
 - 4th year – Delete: Statistics²; Add: BIOL 4300-4301, 4900, COMM 2500, ECON 2000 or 2010, FA 1040, PSYC 1010, History elective, PHYS 2030-2031.
- J. Make the following change to the Pre-Veterinary Medicine (618C) pre-professional program:
- 1st year – Add: COMM 2500² as an option to COMM 1010.
 - Add footnote #2: *Online courses are NOT acceptable for this prerequisite. Additionally, the speech communication requirement is not waived in lieu of work experience, earned degrees or oral-intensive courses.*
- K. Make the following change to the Physical Sciences(637) curriculum:
- 1st year – Add: COMM 2500 as an option to COMM 1010.
