Maternal Child Nursing

The clinical sequence in Maternal-Child Nursing has three functional areas: teaching, leadership, and clinical specialization. Through implementation of a clinical sequence in Maternal-Child Nursing at the graduate level, the Graduate Studies and Research in Nursing Department will prepare nurses who are qualified to function as teachers in institutions of higher education, as leaders in client care settings, or as clinical nurse specialists. The program of studies leading to the MSN with a clinical focus in Maternal-Child Nursing requires a minimum of 39 credits for completion. The Maternal-Child nursing student will complete a professional paper in lieu of thesis.
