**Cost:** \$125 per attendee. Registration includes lab coat and safety goggles. Campers must bring their own lunch, but the camp will provide an afternoon snack. Please make check payable to ASM NSU. Payment can be collected on the first day of Camp.

**Dropoff/Pickup:** Attendees can be dropped off starting at 8:00 AM in the lobby of Bienvenu Hall and picked up in Rm 211 between 3:30 – 5:30 pm in Bienvenu Hall.
