

On-Campus Housing Quarantine Protocol Information

Residential Students are not allowed to quarantine in on-campus housing and must vacate and turn in keys for the duration of the quarantine period.

Residents must vacate on the date informed of the required quarantine. If a student is informed late in the day and the required commute time to off-campus quarantine location will involve driving at night, an extension to the following morning can be requested from the Director of Housing. This request must be made as soon as the resident is notified of the required quarantine.

Quarantine students are to report to the Housing Office located in the Clubhouse area and turn in room keys. If the Housing Office is closed, the RA On-Call is to be contacted for assistance.

International students and students that live outside of Louisiana, Texas, Mississippi and Arkansas may request approval from the Director of Housing to quarantine on campus if space in a quarantine unit is available. These are the only exceptions to the quarantine protocol for Housing. The Director of Housing can be contacted at 318-214-5400. Students who do not fit this category and feel they have extenuating circumstances may seek an appeal through the Director of Housing.

Residents vacating for quarantine should take with them all items that will be needed for the duration of the quarantine period. Quarantined students will not be allowed to return to pick up forgotten items. Clothing, toiletry items, course materials, medication, mobile devices/charger and laptop/charger are suggested items to take.

Windows and doors should be locked, blinds closed, perishable food items and trash removed when vacating apartment.

Quarantine residents should confirm with Health Services or Sports Medicine, if a student athlete, the date cleared to return to on-campus housing and class.

Housing will have the bed space and the common areas within the apartment sanitized of any student that is required to quarantine.
